<b><u>Vocab Word</u></b>	<b><u>Vocab Definition</u></b>
1.)	The surface where the blood ends up.
2.)	A mass of blood and other contaminants caused through clotting mechanisms.
3.)	Point on the body that received a blow, from which blood was shed.
4.)	Blood under pressure that strikes a target.
5.)	The pointed edges of a stain that radiate out to form spatter.
6.)	The angle at which blood strikes a target surface.
7.)	Blood that has been thrown from a secondary object (weapon or hand).
8.)	Created when a volume of blood in excess of 1 mL strikes a surface at low velocity.
9.)	Bloodstains created from the application of force or energy to an area where there is blood.
10.)	The large pattern of blood that is created when blood escapes an artery under pressure; rise and fall of blood pressure is apparent.
11.)	Characteristic patterns present when blood drips into standing, wet blood.
12.)	The area in question lacks blood even though areas surrounding it show blood.
13.)	The droplet from which satellite spatter originated.
14.)	Place in space where the blood came from.
15.)	The transfer of blood onto a target surface by a bloody object that is usually moving laterally.
16.)	Pattern created when a secondary object moves through an existing wet blood stain.
17.)	Blood spattered as a result of breathing.
18.)	Small drops of blood that break off from the parent spatter when the parent droplet strikes a target surface.
19.)	Large patterns under pressure from an artery, but with less volume; distinct rises and falls of blood pressure apparent.
20.)	Pattern left when an object moves through a partially dried stain.
21.)	The pattern created when a wet, bloody object comes in contact with a target surface, leaving a pattern.
